About the Scholarship Program

In 2017, Solicitor Jimmy Richardson of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit Solicitor's Office for Horry and Georgetown Counties launched the LEO Scholarship Program in coordination with the Fraternal Order of Police Coastal Carolina Lodge #12.

The Fifteenth Judicial Circuit Solicitor's Office works intimately with the public safety sector. We appreciate the contribution that our Law Enforcement personnel offer to our communities throughout Horry and Georgetown Counties. To show this appreciation, the program was developed to provide college scholarship awards to deserving active Law Enforcement Officers and/or deserving sons or daughters of active Law Enforcement Officers.

Through this Scholarship Opportunity, Three \$2000.00 scholarships have been made available through the generosity of Solicitor Richardson to be awarded to active LEO's in Horry and Georgetown Counties attending accredited higher education institutions.

The Fifteenth Circuit Solicitor's Office and FOP Coastal Carolina Lodge #12 pride themselves on working with members of Law Enforcement and are always here to help. Along with the Three \$2000.00 scholarships, Solicitor Richardson has also donated \$4000.00 to the FOP's Officer's Distress Fund/ General Educational Fund.

Award Criteria

Scholarships awarded are based on a combination of civic duty, academic achievement, and extracurricular participation within the community. In addition to completing the application and submitting the appropriate documentation, sons or daughters of Active LEO's submitting an application must include an essay explaining: *"What it means to me to have a parent or guardian involved in securing our community."*

(Length of essay is solely at the discretion of the writer.)

Please note:

1. Active Law Enforcement Officers have precedence over all other candidates.
2. All candidates either must be, or have a parent/guardian who is, Active Law Enforcement in either Horry or Georgetown counties.
3. Applicants not having received other financial assistance will take precedence.
4. Applicants must be enrolled in, or already a student in an accredited college, university or technical school. *(Must provide documentation)*
5. Candidates may not be convicted of or be charged with any serious misdemeanors, felonies or be under investigation for any illegal acts.
6. FOP12 will select three candidates to be awarded a \$2,000 scholarship each.
7. Winners will be awarded their scholarships AUGUST 24th, 2017 at the FOP Business meeting.
8. **All applications must be submitted no later than JULY 31st, 2017 to be considered.**
